**Tuesday.** Our journey today begins with a visit to Skipton – ‘Gateway to the Dales’. We take a river cruise on the **Skipton Canal** with a rib-tickling commentary by Dave Spikey with tea and a biscuit included. After our cruise, we journey the short distance to Embsay where we enjoy a ride on the **Embsay & Bolton Abbey Railway** through the picturesque scenery of Bolton.

From here we visit **Bolton Abbey** a ruined priory set in a beautiful and tranquil location alongside the River Wharfe. Surrounded by moorland, woodland, and riverside, this is a truly inspirational setting.

**Wednesday.** After a leisurely breakfast, we head for **Harewood House**, one of the Treasure Houses of



England in the heart of rural Yorkshire. The house holds an impressive art collection including Renaissance masterpieces, and exquisite Thomas Chippendale furniture, all combined with 100 acres of gardens and a renowned lakeside Bird Garden.

Later we journey to **Harrogate** where the rest of the day is free for you to explore at leisure. Perhaps take a stroll through the beautiful Valley Gardens followed by some retail therapy in the delightful Victorian Westminster Arcade or the independent shops of the Montpellier

Quarter. You could maybe even visit the famous ‘Betty’s Tearooms’.

**Thursday.** Our day takes us to the historic cathedral city of **York**, the capital of Yorkshire, and a particularly beautiful city to explore. You could wander through the Shambles, and perhaps visit the National Railway Museum or even the stunning York Minster.

**Friday.** After breakfast, we depart the hotel and head home with fond memories of our time in Yorkshire.

# Delightful Devon

## 5 Days

The Headland Hotel

Set on a headland near Torquay, majestically overlooking Meadfoot Beach and the sea, the Headland Hotel was originally built for the Romanoffs - the Russian Royal Family. All bedrooms are ensuite with television, hairdryer and tea/coffee making facilities.



### Monday

Depart from your home area in the morning and travel to Devon, arriving late afternoon at **Headland Hotel** in Torquay. 4 nights stay – dinner, bed & breakfast. **Tea/coffee and biscuits on arrival.**

**Entertainment is provided on two evenings during your stay.**

### Tuesday

Our day begins with a Devon coastal tour. Following the shore road, we pass through Teignmouth and Dawlish and continue north to the **cathedral city of Exeter**. We take a break here and have time to explore the city before we continue along the Exe estuary to the pleasant resort of **Exmouth**. Here we have time for lunch before we enjoy a **cruise along the River Exe** discovering the history, beauty and wildlife of the river.

### Wednesday

This morning we drive into **Newton Abbot** where it is market day. Enjoy a browse around the stalls and a look at the town where you can obtain lunch. Leaving Newton Abbot, we have a ride to Buckfastleigh. Here we join the **South Devon Railway**. Originally a Great Western Railway branch line, the line hugs the Dart estuary on the journey to Totnes. On arrival, you can stretch your legs before the train returns to **Buckfastleigh**. Here, the railway offers an extensive museum, workshops, gift shop and book shop to explore as well as the award-winning Refreshment Rooms for snacks, cakes and Devon cream teas. After, we return to the coach to make our way back to the hotel.

### Thursday

We head into the South Hams region of Devon. First, we take a break in **Kingsbridge**, the 'capital' of South Devon, with a chance to look around the pleasant town. Moving on we head for **delightful Dartmouth** with its many naval connections, including the Royal Naval College. We have lunchtime here and you can enjoy a lovely stroll along the busy harbour, or just sit and watch the boats. Late afternoon we return to the hotel.



### Friday

After breakfast, we leave and begin our journey home.

# Beautiful Northumbria

6 Days

Sun 14 Sep 2025 - Fri 19 Sep 2025

Copthorne Newcastle The Millennium Copthorne Hotel stands in one of the finest locations in Newcastle, on the banks of the River Tyne, just a short stroll from the city centre. Bedrooms are all facing the river with views across, all are ensuite with satellite television and all the modern-day facilities you would expect from a hotel of this standard.



**Sunday** Depart from your home area travelling to Newcastle, arriving late afternoon at Copthorne Hotel. 5 nights stay – dinner, bed & breakfast. Tea/coffee and biscuits on arrival.

**Monday** This morning we head to the Beamish 'Living Museum of the North', where we step back in time and see how people lived and worked in the late 19th and early 20th century. Staff in period dress add to the amazing atmosphere as they tell their story and guide you through living history. Browse through the schoolhouse, have a peek in the newsagents or even buy freshly baked goods in the bakery! Take the tram to Pockerley Manor and see what farm life was like in the 1820s. After all this excitement, you can even relax in the Sun Inn, a good old-fashioned pub or take a trip to the traditional tearoom.

**Tuesday** We take you on a journey along the Durham Heritage Coast - one of the finest coastlines in England - as we make our way to the lively harbour town of Seaham. We suggest visiting the Seaham Harbour Marina, or perhaps grabbing an ice cream and walking along the coastal footpath enjoying breath taking views. We return to the hotel for an afternoon at leisure in Newcastle.

**Wednesday** Today we take the road north, past Blyth and Ashington, to Amble, Warkworth and historic Alnwick. We visit the magnificent Alnwick Castle, home to the Duke of Northumberland family dating back to 1309. The castle has featured in Downton Abbey and several Harry Potter films. There is much to see, including the sumptuous State Rooms. The beautifully landscaped Alnwick Garden has many unique features, sculptures, the infamous Poison Garden and one of the largest tree houses in the world.



**Thursday** After a leisurely breakfast we travel to the resort of Seahouses on the North Northumberland Heritage Coast. Offshore lie the remote Farne Islands, home to a wide variety of bird and sea life. Following miles of sandy dunes and unspoilt beaches we reach Bamburgh, home of Grace Darling, where the imposing castle looks out to sea. Subject to tidal conditions we travel over the causeway to Lindisfarne (Holy Island), birthplace of British Christianity. NOTE: The crossing of the causeway to Holy Island is governed by tide times. It may be necessary to amend this excursion.

**Friday** After breakfast, we leave and begin our journey home with fond memories of our time in Northumbria.
